

Pioneer Park Swimming Pool Rules

No lifeguard on duty - Swim at your own risk

Pool Hours: 9:00am to 10:00pm

The six" PLEAs" recommended by the CDC for protection against recreational water illnesses:

1. PLEASE do not swim when you have diarrhea. You can spread germs in the water and make other people sick.
2. PLEASE do not swallow pool water. Avoid getting water in your mouth.
3. PLEASE practice good hygiene. Take a shower before swimming and wash your hands after using the toilet or changing diapers.
4. PLEASE take your kids on bathroom breaks or check diapers often. Waiting to hear "I have to go" may mean it's too late.
5. PLEASE change diapers in a bathroom or a diaper changing area and not poolside.
6. PLEASE wash your child thoroughly (especially the rear end) with soap and water before swimming.

General Pool Rules:

1. Members are responsible for their children and guests.
2. No swimming alone.
3. **Children under 12** must be supervised by an **adult OVER the AGE of 18.**
4. Non-swimmers must stay in shallow water.
5. Proper pool attire is required - no nudity.
6. Swim diapers must be used, by order of state laws, on babies and children who are not toilet trained. **Mandatory fine of 100.00** for closure of pool for not following this rule."
7. Children's swim accessories are permitted in shallow water only. **Tubes and rafts are not permitted between 5pm Friday and Sunday (3:00pm on Monday of a holiday weekend)**
8. No sitting or hanging on float lines or ladders.
9. No running, rough play, dunking, pushing, riding on shoulders or spitting in water.
- 10.No diving, flips, splash dives or cannonballs.
- 11.No Frisbees at pools.
- 12.Profanity, improper behavior and vulgar remarks are prohibited.
- 13.No glass in pool area, or in pool. **Mandatory \$100.00 fine for glass in pool area.**
Drinks in plastic containers are allowed on the deck, but not in the water.

- 14.No pets in the pool area.
- 15.No loud music.
- 16.No intoxicated persons allowed in the pool area.
- 17.Admission to the pool is refused to all persons having any contagious disease or infectious condition
18. **NO FOOD** in the pool area. **You must use the picnic area!!!**

Infractions shall be reported to the Park Manager. The word of the Park Manager *is not to be questioned* on matters on violations of the pool rules, the safety and well-being of the swimmers and other patrons.

For Violations of pool rules:

1st Offense - Warning (may include temporary expulsion from the pools)

2nd Offense – Class A penalty

3rd Offense - Expulsion from the pools for one month with a letter to the member explaining repeated infractions and possibility of monetary fines for continued violations.
